

# Rules of the BelTech 4.0 event

organized by TECH365 Sp. z o.o.

## §1. GENERAL PROVISIONS

**1.** These regulations define the rules and conditions of participation in the event “BelTechGlobal 4.0” (also referred to as “BelTech 4.0”), taking place on **25 September 2026**, at **[VENUE]** (hereinafter referred to as the “Event”).

**2.** The organizer of the Event is **TECH365 Spółka z ograniczoną odpowiedzialnością**, headquartered in Warsaw at ul. Wolska 50, 01-187 Warsaw, entered into the register of entrepreneurs of the National Court Register kept by the District Court for the Capital City of Warsaw, under KRS number 0001234989, NIP 5273214145, REGON 544494765 (hereinafter referred to as the “Organizer”).

## §2. RULES OF PARTICIPATION

**1.** Participation in the Event is possible after registering and making payment via the **Luna** registration system, available at: [\[REGISTRATION URL\]](#).

**2. The Organizer reserves the right to cancel a previously issued ticket and to refuse participation in the Event for safety reasons or where necessary to ensure the proper course of the Event.** In particular, the Organizer may cancel a ticket if it has reasonable grounds to suspect that the participant's presence may threaten the safety of other participants, the Organizer's personnel, the venue, or the orderly conduct of the Event. In such case, the Organizer undertakes to refund the full ticket price paid by the participant without undue delay, but no later than 14 days from the date of cancellation. The decision of the Organizer in matters concerning safety is at its sole discretion and is final.

**3.** The number of places is limited, and participation depends on ticket availability.

**4.** A business casual dress code applies at the Event.

## §3. PARTICIPANTS' OBLIGATIONS

**1.** Participants are required to comply with these regulations.

**2.** Participants must behave in a manner that does not disrupt the Event.

**3.** Participants are obliged to follow safety instructions issued by the Organizer, the Organizer's personnel, and the venue staff.

## §4. ORGANIZER'S OBLIGATIONS

**1.** The Organizer undertakes to conduct the Event in accordance with the program available on the website **beltech.global**.

**2.** The Organizer reserves the right to introduce minor changes due to circumstances beyond its control.

## **§5. PERSONAL DATA PROTECTION**

- 1.** The administrator of personal data of Event participants is **TECH365 Sp. z o.o.**, headquartered in Warsaw, ul. Wolska 50, 01-187 Warsaw, email: **info@beltech.global**.
- 2.** Participants' personal data will be processed for the purpose of organizing and conducting the Event, as well as fulfilling the Organizer's legal obligations, pursuant to Art. 6(1)(b) and (c) of the GDPR.
- 3.** Personal data will be stored for the period necessary to carry out the Event and to handle any claims, and thereafter for the period required by law.
- 4.** Recipients of the data may include entities cooperating with the Organizer in the implementation of the Event (e.g., IT providers, technical support, the Luna registration system operator), only to the extent necessary to achieve the purposes specified above.
- 5.** Participants have the right to access their data, to correct (rectify), delete, restrict processing, transfer, and object to its processing.
- 6.** Participants have the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Personal Data Protection Office if they believe that the processing of their data violates GDPR provisions.
- 7.** Providing personal data is voluntary but necessary to participate in the Event.

## **§6. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY**

- 1.** All materials presented and made available to participants are protected by copyright and constitute the intellectual property of their creators.
- 2.** Participants agree to use materials provided during the Event solely for personal use, without the right to copy, distribute, publish, or use them for commercial purposes without the prior consent of the author or Organizer.
- 3.** It is prohibited to distribute programs, agendas, presentations, training materials, and other content that constitutes part of the Event program, in whole or in part, in any form, without the prior consent of the Organizer.
- 4.** The Organizer reserves the right to record the Event (in audio, video, and photographic form) and to use the resulting materials for documentation, promotional, and educational purposes.
- 5.** Participation in the Event implies consent to the recording of the participant's image during the Event and its subsequent publication in the Organizer's informational and promotional materials.

## **§7. FINAL PROVISIONS**

- 1.** The regulations are available on the Event's website (beltech.global).
- 2.** The Organizer reserves the right to amend these regulations.
- 3.** In matters not regulated by these regulations, the provisions of Polish law shall apply, in particular the Civil Code.
